WORKSHOPS








GLOBAL SOLUTIONS SUMMIT 2023

By the numbers Participating countries REALIGNING SOCIETIES: TOWARDS A SUSTAINABLE, INCLUSIVE, AND COMMON FUTURE

The Global Solutions Summit 2023 was held on May 15-16 and saw spirited participation from over 1,000 policy experts, researchers, and practitioners at ESMT Berlin. The event took a global view on today's systemic

crises and looked at urgently-needed global solutions. With the title "Realigning Societies: Towards a Sustainable, Inclusive, and Common Future," the 2023 edition presented over 202 speakers in 49 sessions.

Discussions strived to tackle the most pressing questions of our times: What is the role of the G20 and G7 in promoting global action on salient issues? How can we make the climate agenda and action more inclusive and equitable? How can the Global South and North come together to achieve SDG targets? Are international institutions and forums like the G20 and G7 equipped to deal with a multi-crisis world?





The Summit achieved an excellent balance in terms of sectoral, geographic, and participant diversity.



ince 2017, the Young Global Changers program has attracted over 500 students, young professionals, social entrepreneurs, non-profit-leaders and activists from 150 different countries from around the world, dedicated to changing the world for the better.

The program identifies, connects, empowers and supports these young people from different areas of society who are already actively pushing for change in their communities, enabling them to build a global community and become part of an impactful multistakeholder network.



YOUNG GLOBAL CHANGERS **RECOUPLING AWARDS**





With the "Young Global Changers Recoupling Awards" the Global Solutions Initiative aims to identify, recognize and reward young changemakers from all over the world who contribute actively towards a better alignment – a "recoupling" – of economic prosperity with environmental sustainability and the needs and demands of societies, communities and individuals.

The award recognizes concrete practices and impactful youth-led projects and initiatives that drive change on the ground, while also serving as examples and inspiration beyond their immediate impact. Projects can be social enterprises as well as youth-led non-profit initiatives.









GLOBAL

Several hundred young changemakers from around the world apply each year to become members of the YGC global network. Between 50 and 60 new members are selected each year for their contributions towards the recoupling of our economies with societies and the environment. All new members become part of a global community of dedicated changemakers with members in all regions of the world.

YOUTH-LED

The Young Global Changers represent a new generation of changemakers. The YGC provide new perspectives and offer tangible, praxis-based input into global policy debates. The activities of the YGC network aim to facilitate solution-driven collaboration across generations. They are designed to integrate young people, enabling them to learn and grow as leaders and future facilitators of change.

COLLABORATIVE

The Young Global Changers connect regularly with their fellow community members from around the world. They meet in online community sessions and are invited to organize in-person events in their regions and communities. Each region of the world has its own YGC Ambassador. Community members learn from one another and engage in joint activities to advance and implement the recoupling vision.

IMPACTFUL

The YGC program selects and showcases the most inspiring and impactful youth-led initiatives from around the world. Projects are selected based on their impact towards the recoupling of our economies with societies and the environment. The most inspiring initiatives will take center stage at the annual Global Solutions Summit in Berlin. They become an integral part of the Global Solutions efforts towards recou-


