OVERVIEW

The Global Solutions Initiative is collecting submissions for a new blog series: *Solution Spaces: For People and Planet*. Blogs will be flanked by additional formats, including longer articles, social media and multimedia formats such as a podcast.

- Audience: Educated, non-expert, general public
- Style: Accessible, high-quality prose, razor-sharp insights, jargon-free
- Frequency: Weekly (average; to be increased at key moments).
- Topics: All submissions should address collective approaches to multilateral challenges relevant to the G20, G7 and other international fora, as well as support the mission of GSI, which strives to "mobilize change to recouple economic progress with social and environmental prosperity."
- General principle: Focus on concrete policy recommendations and possible solutions to global challenges

- Author(s') full name and organizational affiliation
- Thematic focus

Manuscript requirements:

- American English
- Please submit an open file (.docx)
- Word limits: 500 1000 words
 - Headline: max. 40 characters incl. spaces—please consider that the blogs are written for a non-technical audience



o Subline (optional): max. 80 characters incl. spaces

o Main text: max. 800 words

o Please refrain from using an overabundance of abbreviations or citations
